Application for Tuition Fee Scholarship
Master of Economics Program (English Program)
Academic Year 1/2020
(First Round)

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Master of Economics Program (English Program). NIDA is granting scholarships. The scholarships granted are classified into two types:

- 1. Scholarship Type 1** Scholarship recipients shall be waived from tuition fees throughout the program of study. Monthly allowances and other educational support will also be provided throughout the program.
- 2. Scholarship Type 2** Scholarship recipients shall be waived from tuition fees throughout the program of study.

1. Qualification of Applicants

1.1 Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree in any field or major from an accredited academic institution. All applicants must have a minimum cumulative of 2.75 GPA in their Bachelor's degree.

1.2 Applicants, currently employed, must obtain written approval from their employer to pursue full time study at NIDA.

2. Application Procedure and Fees

2.1 Online Application. Applications can see the information about the application for admission on the Announcement of National Institute of Development Administration to Master of Economics Program (English Program) at <https://entrance.nida.ac.th>.

2.2 Applying in Person. Application can be made in person at the Educational Service Division, 3rd Floor, Prince Naradhip Bongsprabandha Building between 8.30 – 16.30 hrs (except government holidays).

- Now – February 7th, 2020

2.3 Application forms can be obtained by contacting the Educational Service Division, 3rd Floor, Prince Naradhip Bongsprabandha Building between 8.30 – 16.30 hrs (except government holidays and Friday, January 3rd, 2020) or the Graduate School of Development Economics, 14th Floor, Navamindradhiraj Building, NIDA, Seri Thai Road, Bangkok District, Bangkok.

Note: The downloaded application form must be printed out on A4 paper only. Do not change the format of the form, otherwise, it will not be accepted for the application process.

2.5 Applications, accompanied by an application fee of 200 baht, must be submitted to the Educational Service Division at the Financial Division, 3rd Floor, Prince Naradhip Bongsprabandha Building between 8.30 – 16.30 hrs (except government holidays and Friday, January 3rd, 2020).

- 3.3 One copy of complete official transcript(s) of undergraduate studies

- 3.6 One copy of evidence of any change of name (if applicable)
- 3.7 One 1-inch photo taken no more than six months prior to application date
- 3.8 For applicants who graduated from an institute outside Thailand:

3.8.1 A Letter of Confirmation on Standard Curriculum for the Bachelor's Degree. 3.8.2 An Official Letter of Certification for their Bachelor's Degree with their University Council's approval as well as a complete transcript with the specified date of graduation which must be sent directly from the applicant's university to the address below:

Note: The documents mentioned in 3.8.1 and 3.8.2 above, must be submitted before the start of the semester. Applicants who fail to submit all required documents will not be admitted to the program.

The Institute reserves the right to verify the applicants' qualifications at any time. Applicants who do not have the required qualifications will not be admitted to the program. No refunds will be issued. If an applicant has already been accepted but is subsequently determined to be unqualified, scholarship awards will be canceled.

4. Selection Procedures

The program committee will decide applicants who are to be interviewed by the faculty members of the Graduate School of Development Economics. The committee will evaluate applicants based on credentials, education, and experience.
