New Application for Admission

Master of Economics Program in Economics and Management (English Program) Batch 10

Semester 1 Academic Year 2025

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Master of Economics Program in Economics and Management (English Program) Batch 10 for the Semester 1 Academic year 2025 as follows:

1. Qualification of the Applicants

To be eligible for admission, applicants must have one of the following criteria:

- 1.1 Applicants must have one of the following test scores:
 - 1) TOEFL 500 or above
 - 2) IELTS 5.5 or above
 - 3) NIDATEAP 500 or above
 - 4) English Test by the Chinese government Score level 6 or above, or
- 1.2 Applicants must have a GPA of 2.70 or above at the undergraduate level, or
- 1.3 Applicants must have 1 year of work experience (calculated from the start of the semester), **or**
- 1.4 Applicants must have graduated from an undergraduate program taught entirely in English or be an international student whose native language is English.

Note: Applicants who qualify based on criteria 1.2 or 1.3 are required to enroll in LC4001 and LC4002 courses offered by the Faculty of Language and Communication, unless they have a TOEFL score of 500 or above, an IELTS score of 5.5 or above, a NIDATEAP score of 500 or above, or an English Test by the Chinese government score of Level 6 or above within their first semester of enrollment.

2. Selection Procedure

The committee will interview and consider by the faculty members of the Graduated School of Development Economics. The committee will evaluate applicants based on credentials, education, and experiences.

3. Online Application

- 3.1 Application fee 200 baht
- 3.2 Applicants can visit http://entrance.nida.ac.th and have to follow the following instructions :
 - 1) Register for getting into the online application system.
 - 2) Set a password and confirm
 - 3) Apply for entrance examination by choosing a school and a program of study.
 - 4) Fill out profile information.
 - 5) Confirm the application.
 - 6) Print an invoice of application fee.
- 7) Save the application information, verify the information and confirm the application.
- 8) Print a bill payment fee 200 baht for the application and the payment must be made by March 20^{th} 2025
- Applicants within Thailand transfer can be made via the Bangkok Bank to National Institute of Development Administration, Account No. 944-3-00042-8, Bangkok Bank, National Institute of Development Administration Sub-branch.
- Applicants outside Thailand transfer can be made via the Bangkok Bank to National Institute of Development Administration, Savings Account No. 944-0-01411-7, Bangkok Bank, National Institute of Development Administration Sub-branch. Money orders and bills of exchange are not accepted.
 - 9) Submit the required documents within March 20th 2025

10) If applicants are unable to complete documentation and payment process the application will be considered invalid.

2. The application is complete when the Institute verifies the application documents and payment made within the prescribed time. Applicants can monitor application status after the payment has been made for 2 days at http://entrance.nida.ac.th

- 4.8.2 An Official Letter of Certification for their Bachelor's Degree with their University Council's approval as well as a complete transcript with the specified date of graduation which must be sent directly from the applicant's university to the address below:
