

## Announcement of the Graduate School of Development Economics Guidelines and Submission of Assignments FN 7000 Workshop in Financial Engineering Research for Semester 1 of the Academic Year 2025

According to the Graduate School of Development Economics offering the course FN 7000 Workshop in Financial Engineering Research to students of the Master of Science in Financial Engineering program for Semester 1, Academic Year 2025.

The Graduate School of Development Economics has set the following guidelines and submission procedures.

- 1) Students must consult with their advisor for no less than 9 hours within the semester in which they are enrolled, or as deemed appropriate by the advisor.
- 2) All students must present their work for the FN 7000 Workshop in Financial Engineering Research on either Saturday or Sunday, as scheduled by their advisor, between **November 24, 2025 to December 8, 2025**. Each presentation will be attended by two faculty members: one from the National Institute of Development Administration and one from King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang.
- 3) Students must submit their final work to their advisor by December 15, 2025, via the advisor's email or any other channel specified by the advisor. Both Word and PDF files should be submitted.
- 4) Students who receive an "I" grade or a grade lower than a "B" in this course are not allowed to register for FN 9000 Independent Study in the following semester, <u>unless</u> they have submitted their work and received approval from their advisor to register for FN 9000 Independent Study by December 29, 2025.

## Note:

- 1. Students are not permitted to modify or resubmit files after the final work has been submitted, as specified in clause 3).
- 2. Students who receive an 'I' grade will be assigned a final grade no higher than a 'B' after submitting their work.
